



PBC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The primary purpose of the PBC Scholarship is to offer financial assistance to incoming students enrolled in PBC School. The Scholarship program will be awarded on the basis of academic promise or achievement, and it will be given per program (divided quarterly), and the recipients are required to maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B average) to remain eligible for the scholarship.

A total of thirty individual members (applicants) will be selected for the scholarship; ten recipients from each of the following categories:

- Ten (10) recipients from the BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing) program.
- Ten (10) recipients from the RN (Registered Nurse) program.
- Ten (10) recipients from the PN (Practical Nursing) program.

Eligibility

The eligibility requirements include the following:

- The applicant must be an incoming student, admitted to the relevant program.
- The payment of the registration fee is required.
- The applicant must be a current student at PBC School.
- The applicant must demonstrate financial need, academic achievement, leadership qualities and/or community involvement.

Note: The scholarship amounts are designated for covering tuition fees exclusively and are subject to change at any time. The applicants who meet the eligibility requirements must apply for the scholarship within a specified deadline.

Application Process

Before completing the application below, the applicants should ensure they fulfill all the criteria mentioned above and submit their applications within the stipulated deadline. It's also important to note the specific focus areas for evaluation, such as the required registration fee, being admitted or enrolled to PBCC School of Nursing, financial need, academic achievement, leadership, or community involvement, as these factors may play a crucial role in the selection process.

To apply for the PBC Scholarship, please complete and submit the application and essay as outlined below:

- Step 1– Complete and submit/return the application to the office of registrar by the specified deadline.
- Step 2– Submit a personal statement, showing that you or your family face financial challenges that make it difficult to cover the costs of education; demonstrating your leadership skills; demonstrating your engagement in community service or activities outside of the classroom; and/or demonstrating your academic performance, such as your GPA, standardized test scores, and any notable academic achievements or honors.
- Step 3– provide clear and compelling evidence for each aspect.
- Step 4– Applications will be reviewed by the President/Executive Committee, and the selected applicants will be notified within 1-2 weeks after the specified deadline.
